Macerated for 12 hours (in contrast to the single-vineyard wines, which are macerated for 24 hours) the 2020 Grüner Veltliner Credo shows an intense but refined and flinty bouquet of crushed stones and candied lemon peel. On the palate, this is a full-bodied but refined and elegant, stimulatingly fresh, finessed and salty Veltliner with fine bitters on the finish. The wine was aged in used 500-liter barrels and barriques until August 2021 before it was bottled under natural cork with 13.5% alcohol and four grams of unfermented sugar. This is a pretty harmonious and elegant Veltliner that is really excellent. Tasted in January 2022.
