The 2017 Tinto Terrenus Clos dos Muros is a field blend from old vines (over a century) dominated by Grand Noir (which Rui calls similar to Alicante but fresher), Alicante Bouschet, Alfrocheiro and others, all aged for 24 months in a new 1,000-liter foudre. It comes in at 14.1% alcohol. Silky and bright, this shows a bit of oak but more fruit and flavor, all supported nicely by the structure. It's firm on the finish and has gorgeous mid-palate finesse. This is likely to age well and develop even more complexity along the way. It looks like a 20-year wine at least; Rui says "or more."
