The 2021 Fernão Pires Vinhas Velhas was produced with grapes 90 years of age and might have a small percentage of other varieties (mostly Alicante Branco), planted on sandy soils. The full clusters were pressed, and the juice fermented in 500-liter barrels and aged for 10 months. It comes in at 12% alcohol, with a pH of 3.4 and 5.95 grams of acidity. This is clean and harmonious, surprisingly fresh with a citrus twist, sharp and tangy, with a very fine thread in the palate. It's supple and tasty, finishing dry and with a stony quality that I like. 700 bottles and 54 magnums produced. It was bottled in July 2022.
