The 2021 Pinot Noir was produced with grapes from 10-year-old vines on clay-rich soils. It fermented in lagar, and the grapes were foot trodden. It matured in neutral 225- and 500-liter barrels for 18 months. This is varietal, with floral and berry notes with a balsamic twist. The oak is neatly integrated, and the tannins are fine, with a chalky character. It comes in at 13% alcohol with a pH of 3.74 and 5.59 grams of acidity. A total of 900 bottles, 30 magnums and 10 double magnums were produced. It was bottled in August 2023.
